

PASTORAL JOURNEY TO SOUTH AFRICA

*Travel Arrangements**

- Thursday
May 19** **INDIANAPOLIS Departure.** Meet (11:00 a.m.) at the Delta Air Lines ticket counter, Indianapolis International Airport for departure (1:05 p.m.) on Delta Air Lines flight DL #5372 for New York; non-stop Canadair Regional Jet service. Arrive (4:10 p.m.) New York John F. Kennedy International Airport, Terminal 3, and proceed to connecting departure (5:55 p.m.) on South African Airways flight SA #204 for Johannesburg; one-stop (Dakar, Senegal) Airbus 340 service with meals served en route.
- Friday
May 20** **JOHANNESBURG Arrival.** Arrive (17.05) at Johannesburg International Airport and meet your private guide, then transfer by private motorcoach to the HOLIDAY INN GARDEN COURT. Group (19.00) dinner at the hotel with guest speaker Dr. Mxolisi Mavi, the executive director from Church Community Leadership Trust. He will address the group on the main issues confronting South Africa as a nation and the church in South Africa. **(D)**
- Saturday
May 21** **JOHANNESBURG/PRETORIA.** Morning (09.00) departure by private motorcoach for Soweto. Visit the Hector Peterson Museum. Meet with church and political leaders at Regina Mundi Church, discussing the uprising and the current situation. Lunch (13.00) at *Wandies Restaurant*. Afternoon tour of Pretoria, the capital city of South Africa, including the Voortrekker Monument, Kruger House, Church Square, City Hall, Theatre Opera House, and Union Buildings. Meet host families (17.00) at the Wesley Church, The Methodist Church of South Africa, for dinner and overnight. **(B,L,D)**
- Sunday
May 22** **PRETORIA.** Morning (09.30) worship at Wesley Church, meeting with church leaders following the service. Return to Johannesburg for guided tour of the Apartheid Museum. Proceed to the HOLIDAY INN GARDEN COURT for check-in. Group dinner (19.00) at the hotel. **(B,L,D)**
- Monday
May 23** **JOHANNESBURG/KRUGER PARK.** Morning (07.30) departure by private motorcoach for meeting with South African Council of Churches. Transfer to Johannesburg International Airport for departure (13.45) on South African Airways flight SA #8132 (operated by South African Airways Airlink) to Mpumalanga; turbo-prop service with lunch served en route. Arrive (14.40) at Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport and meet your private guide, then transfer to PRETORIUSKOP REST CAMP for check-in. Group dinner at camp. **(B,D)**
- Tuesday
May 24** **KRUGER PARK.** Morning (06.30) departure for game drive in open vehicles with stop for lunch at rest camp. Afternoon free. Group dinner at camp. **(B,L,D)**
- Wednesday
May 25** **KRUGER PARK/CAPE TOWN.** Morning (09.30) transfer to Kruger Mpumalanga International Airport for departure (11.25) on South African Airways #8801 (operated by South African Airways Airlink) to Cape Town; Embraer jet service with lunch served en route. Arrive (13.50) at Cape Town D.F. Malan Airport and meet your private guide, then transfer to VICTORIA & ALFRED HOTEL for check-in, with orientation tour of city en route. Group dinner (19.00) at *Oyo Restaurant*. **(B,D)**

- Thursday
May 26** **CAPE TOWN.** Morning (09.00) departure full-day Peninsula Tour, beginning with walk in Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens. Travel past Sea Point and Camps Bay, along the Atlantic Seaboard through Noordhoek and Scarborough. Group lunch at *Seaforth Restaurant*. Afternoon visit to Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve, then ride the funicular to the scenic viewing point near where the Indian and Atlantic Oceans meet. Visit Boulder Beach to view the penguins and stop at the naval port of Simon's Town en route back to the hotel. Group dinner (19.00) at *Green Dolphin*. **(B,L,D)**
- Friday
May 27** **CAPE TOWN.** Morning (09.00) departure for visit to Christel House, a private school for under privileged children. Continue to Stellenbosch to visit the Stellenbosch Farmers' Winery Centre with a stop for lunch at *Moyo Restaurant*. Return to Cape Town for dinner (19.00) at *Hildebrand Restaurant*. **(B,L,D)**
- Saturday
May 28** **CAPE TOWN.** Morning (09.00) departure for a tour of the townships, including Bo-Kaap (a Malay Quarter), District Six, including the museum, Langa, the oldest apartheid housing scheme in the townships, and Guguletu. Enjoy lunch at *Greek Fisherman* before walking to the pier for boarding (13.30) for an afternoon cruise and tour of Robben Island, including Nelson Mandela's cell and the limestone quarry where prisoners worked. Farewell (19.00) dinner at *Oyo Restaurant*. **(B,L,D)**
- Sunday
May 29** **CAPE TOWN Departure.** Morning (08.30) departure by private motorcoach for worship (09.15) at St. George's Cathedral, meeting with church leaders following the service. Enjoy lunch at *Four Quay Restaurant*, then transfer to the Cape Town D.F. Malan Airport for departure (15.10) on South African Airways flight SA #346; non-stop 737 service to Johannesburg. Arrive (17.10) at Johannesburg International Airport and proceed to connecting departure (19.50) on South African Airways flight SA #209 for Atlanta; one-stop (Sid, Cape Verde) Airbus 340 service with meals served en route. **(B,L)**
- Monday
May 30** **INDIANAPOLIS Arrival.** Arrive (8:20 a.m.) at Atlanta Hartsfield International Airport, South Terminal, clear customs and proceed to connecting departure (11:30 a.m.) on Delta Air Lines flight DL #232 for Indianapolis; nonstop Boeing 737 service. Arrive (12:07 p.m.) at Indianapolis International Airport.
