- Friday  
March 3** **DETROIT Departure.** Meet (10:00 a.m.) at the American Airlines ticket counter, Detroit Metropolitan Airport, L.C. Smith Terminal, for departure (12:11 p.m.) on American Airlines flight AA #1153 for Miami; non-stop Boeing 737 service with food for purchase en route (check baggage through to Rio). Upon arrival (3:08 p.m.) at Miami International Airport, proceed to connecting departure (8:00 p.m.) on Varig Airlines flight RG #8819 for São Paulo; non-stop Boeing 767 services with a meal served en route.
- Saturday  
March 4** **RIO DE JANEIRO Arrival.** Upon arrival (06.05) at São Paulo International Airport, proceed to connecting Varig Airlines flight RG #8943 departing (07.40) for Rio de Janeiro; non-stop Boeing 757 service with refreshments served en route. Arrive (08.40) at Rio de Janeiro Airport and transfer by private motorcoach, with assistance, to IBIZA COPACABANA HOTEL for check-in. Afternoon (13.00) guided tour of Rio including the beaches, Botafogo Harbor, Urca District, entrance to the National History Museum and a cable car ride to Sugar Loaf Mountain.
- Sunday  
March 5** **RIO DE JANEIRO.** Morning (08.30) departure by private motorcoach for half-day beach tour including a stop at Corcovado Hill. Visit the Handcrafts & Art Fair of Ipanema. **OPTIONAL:** Ticket for evening theater performance at Plataforma (subject to availability). **(B)**

March 6** **RIO DE JANEIRO.** Morning (09.00) departure by private motorcoach for a half-day guided favela tour to Rocinha. **OPTIONAL:** Afternoon visit to the Botanical Gardens. **(B)**

March 7** **RIO DE JANEIRO/SALVADOR.** Morning (07.30) departure by private motorcoach, with assistance, to Rio de Janeiro Airport for departure (09.30) on Varig Airlines flight RG # 2312 to Salvador; non-stop Boeing 737 service with snack served en route. Upon arrival (11.25) at Salvador Airport, proceed as arranged by instructor to SOL VICTORIA MARINA HOTEL for check-in. **(B)**

March 10** **SALVADOR.** Brazilian buffet breakfast daily. Program arrangements by course instructors. **(B)**

March 11** **SALVADOR.** Day free for independent exploration. **(B)**
- Sunday  
March 12** **SALVADOR Departure/MIAMI Arrival.** Transfer to Salvador Airport, as arranged by course instructors, for departure (06.50) on Varig Airlines flight RG #2331 for São Paulo; non-stop Boeing 737 service with a snack served en route (check baggage through to Miami). Upon arrival (09.20) at São Paulo International Airport, Terminal 2, proceed to connecting departure (11.30) on Varig Airlines flight RG #8810 for Miami; non-stop Boeing 777 service with a lunch served en route. Upon arrival (5:40 p.m.) at Miami International Airport, claim baggage and clear customs, then transfer by complimentary airport shuttle to MIAMI AIRPORT MARRIOTT for check-in.
- Monday  
March 13** **MIAMI Departure/DETROIT Arrival.** Meet (6:15 a.m.) at the American Airlines ticket counter, Miami International Airport, for departure on American Airlines flight AA #1294 departing (8:19 a.m.) for Detroit; non-stop Boeing 737 service with food for purchase en route. Arrive (11:24 a.m.) at Detroit Metropolitan Airport, L.C. Smith Terminal.
