*Travel Arrangements**

- Wednesday
January 4** **INDIANAPOLIS Departure.** Meet (11:30 a.m.) your Seminars International representative at the Northwest Airlines ticket counter at the Indianapolis International Airport for departure (1:27 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #1010 for Detroit; non-stop DC-9 service (check baggage through to Rome). Upon arrival (2:40 p.m.) at the Detroit Metropolitan Airport, McNamara Terminal, proceed to connecting departure (4:00 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #40 to Amsterdam; non-stop Airbus 330 service with meals served en route.
- Thursday
January 5** **ROME Arrival.** Upon arrival (05.55) at the Amsterdam Schiphol Airport, proceed to connecting departure (06.50) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #8497 (operated by KLM Royal Dutch Airlines) to Rome; non-stop Boeing 737 service with breakfast served en route. Arrive (9.15) at the Rome Fiumicino Airport and transfer, with assistance, to the NAPOLEON HOTEL for check-in.
- Friday
January 6** **ROME.** Visit the Castel S. Angelo Museum. 7-day CIS Rome public transport pass provided, covering all metro and local buses in Rome. 7-day Rome Archaeological Card provided. Group dinner (19.00) at *Ristorante Al Cavallino Bianco*. **(B,D)**
- Saturday
January 7** **ROME.** Visits to the Roman Forum, Colosseum, Arch of Constantine, Forum of Trajan and the Temple of Mars Ultor, as arranged by course instructors. **(B)**
- Sunday
January 8** **ROME.** Visits to the Capitoline Museum and Theater of Marcellus, as arranged by course instructors. **(B)**
- Monday
January 9** **ROME.** Early Christian Church walk, including Santa Maria Maggiore, Santa Prassede, San Clemente and Santa Sabina's Basilica, as arranged by course instructors. **(B)**
- Tuesday
January 10** **ROME.** Visit the Baths of Caracalla and St. John in Lateran Basilica, as arranged by course instructors. **(B)**
- Wednesday
January 11** **ROME.** Guided (10.30 tour of Vatican Museums, Sistine Chapel and entrance to the catacombs in St. Peter's Basilica including the sarcophagus of Giunio Basso. **(B)**
- Thursday
January 12** **ROME Departure.** Morning (09.00) visit to the Borghese Gallery. Make your own way to the Rome Termini Station for departure (18.10) on the overnight train EN #224 to Paris (2nd class, 6 berth couchettes). **(B)**
- Friday
January 13** **PARIS Arrival.** Arrive (09.10) at the Paris Gare de Bercy and transfer by private motorcoach, with assistance, to the HOTEL TRIANON RIVE GAUCHE for check-in. Walking tour of the city, as arranged by course instructors. 5-day Paris Visite transport pass provided for unlimited travel within central zones 1-3.
- Saturday
January 14** **PARIS.** Visit the Musée Carnavalet, as arranged by course instructors. 5-day Paris Museum pass provided. **(B)**
- Sunday
January 15** **PARIS.** Visit the Conciergerie and the Pantheon, as arranged by course instructors. **(B)**

January 16** **PARIS.** Morning (09.00) visit the Musée du Louvre. **(B)**
- Tuesday
January 17** **PARIS.** Visit the Musée National des Monuments Français, Champs de Mars and the Eiffel Tower, as arranged by course instructors. **(B)**
- Wednesday** **PARIS.** Visit Les Invalides and the Tomb of Napoleon, as arranged by course instructors. 2-

- January 18** day Paris Visite transport pass provided for unlimited travel within central zones 1-3. **(B)**

January 19** **PARIS.** Visit the Musée Jacquemart-André, as arranged by course instructors. **(B)**
- Friday
January 20** **PARIS/INDIANAPOLIS.** Morning (07.30) departure by private motorcoach, with assistance, to the Paris Charles de Gaulle Airport, Terminal F, for departure (10.30) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #8430 (operated by KLM Royal Dutch Airlines) for Amsterdam; non-stop Boeing 737 service with a snack served en route. Upon arrival (11.55) at the Amsterdam Schiphol Airport, proceed to connecting departure (14.35) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #53 for Detroit; non-stop Airbus 330 service with meals served en route. Upon arrival (5:30 p.m.) at the Detroit Metropolitan Airport, clear customs and proceed to connecting departure (7:00 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW#2863; non-stop regional jet service. Arrive (8:12 p.m.) at the Indianapolis International Airport.
