- Wednesday  
January 2**      **TWIN CITIES Departure.** Meet (11:30 a.m.) your Seminars International representative at the Northwest Airlines group check-in counter, lower T level (tram level), Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport Lindbergh Terminal for departure (1:25 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #307 for Los Angeles; non-stop Airbus 320 service with food for purchase offered en route (check baggage through to Auckland). Upon arrival (3:19 p.m.) at Los Angeles International Airport Terminal 2, proceed to connecting departure (9:30 p.m.) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #5 for Auckland; non-stop Boeing 747 service with meals served en route.

January 3**      **EN ROUTE.** Cross the International Date Line.
- Friday  
January 4**      **AUCKLAND Arrival.** Arrive (07.15) at Auckland International Airport and transfer by private motorcoach, with assistance to the SCENIC CIRCLE AIREDALE HOTEL for early check-in. Morning (12.00) bush and beach tour with a naturalist, including lunch. Group dinner (19.00) and orientation meeting at the hotel. **(L,D)**

Arrive (11.35) on the South Island and transfer by private motorcoach to Nelson for check-in at the LEISURE LODGE NELSON. <b>Sunday January 20</b>	<b>QUEENSTOWN/STEWART ISLAND.</b> Afternoon (13.00) motorcoach and ferry travel to Stewart Island. Check-in at the BAY HOTEL (24 students) or the SOUTH SEAS HOTEL (2 students). Evening class and exploration of the Oban area. <b>(B)</b>
<b>Monday January 21</b>	<b>STEWART ISLAND.</b> Depart (08.00) hotel for full-day tour of Ulva Island Reserve, including lunch. <b>(B,L)</b>

<b>Friday January 25</b>	<b>CHRISTCHURCH.</b> Morning (09.00-11.00) classroom space. Farewell dinner (19.00) at the hotel. <b>(B,D)</b>
<b>Saturday January 26</b>	<b>CHRISTCHURCH/TWIN CITIES.</b> Morning (10.00) departure by private motorcoach to the International Antarctic Centre. Continue to Christchurch International Airport for departure (13.35) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #524 for Auckland; non-stop Boeing 737 service (check baggage through to the Twin Cities). Upon arrival (14.55) at Auckland International Airport, proceed to connecting departure (19.15) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #6 for Los Angeles; non-stop Boeing 747 service with meals served en route. Upon arrival (10:10 a.m.) at Los Angeles International Airport, clear customs, re-check bags and proceed to connecting departure (4:05 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #308 for Minneapolis; non-stop Boeing 757 service with food for purchase offered en route. Arrive (9:36 p.m.) at Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport, Lindbergh Terminal. <b>(B)</b>
