January 3** **TWIN CITIES Departure.** Meet (12:30 p.m.) your Seminars International representative at the Northwest Airlines group check-in counter, lower T level (tram level), Lindbergh Terminal, Minneapolis–St. Paul International Airport, for departure (2:30 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #315 for Los Angeles; non-stop Airbus 320 service with food for purchase en route (check baggage through to Sydney). Upon arrival (4:25 p.m.) at Los Angeles International Airport, Terminal 2, proceed to connecting departure (9:15 p.m.) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #1 for Auckland; non-stop Boeing 777 service with meals served en route.

January 5** **SYDNEY.** Upon arrival (07.25) at Auckland International Airport, International Terminal, proceed to connecting departure (09.00) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #103 for Sydney; non-stop Boeing 767 service with breakfast served en route. Upon arrival (10.30) at Sydney Airport, Terminal 1, transfer by private motorcoach, with local assistant, to QUALITY INN CAMBRIDGE HOTEL for check-in. Afternoon (12.30) departure by private motorcoach to *Sydney Tower Restaurant* for buffet lunch. Afternoon (14.00) touring including The Rocks, Mrs. Macquarie’s Chair, Double and Rose Bays, the Gap, Bondi Beach and Paddington, followed by a walking tour of the area. **(L)**

Upon arrival (16.30) at Auckland International Airport, International Terminal, proceed to connecting departure (19.15) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #6 for Los Angeles; non-stop Boeing 747 service with meals served en route.
