

## NEW ZEALAND CONFERENCE

### *Travel Arrangements\**

- Saturday  
April 11** **TWIN CITIES Departure.** Assemble (3:00 p.m.) at the Northwest Airlines check-in counter, Minneapolis–St. Paul International Airport, Lindberg Terminal, for departure (5:00 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #303 for Los Angeles, non-stop Boeing 757 service (check baggage through to Auckland), with food for purchase available en route. Arrive (6:56 p.m.) at Los Angeles International Airport, Terminal 2, and proceed to connecting departure (10:30 p.m.) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #5 for Auckland; non-stop Boeing 747 service with meals served en route.
- CHICAGO Departure.** Assemble (3:00 p.m.) at the American Airlines check-in counter, Chicago O'Hare International Airport, Terminal 3, for departure (5:00 p.m.) on American Airlines flight AA #557 for Los Angeles, non-stop MD80 service (check baggage through to Auckland), with food for purchase available en route. Arrive (7:30 p.m.) at Los Angeles International Airport, Terminal 4, and proceed to Terminal 2 for connecting departure (10:30 p.m.) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #5 for Auckland; non-stop Boeing 747 service with meals served en route.
- LOS ANGELES Departure.** Assemble (8:00 p.m.) at the Air New Zealand check-in counter, Los Angeles International Airport, Terminal 2, for departure (10:30 p.m.) on Air New Zealand flight NZ #5 for Auckland; non-stop Boeing 747 service, with meals served en route.
- Sunday  
April 12** **CROSS INTERNATIONAL DATE LINE.**
- Monday  
April 13** **AUCKLAND-TAKAPUNA Arrival.** Upon arrival (06.25) at Auckland Airport, transfer by private vehicle, with assistance, to the SPENCER ON BYRON HOTEL for check-in, with en route city tour of Auckland.

April 17** **AUCKLAND-TAKAPUNA.** Program arrangements by course instructor. Immerse yourself in the culture of New Zealand while attending the 4<sup>th</sup> International School Social Work Conference with attendees from many different countries. A hot breakfast, lunch and afternoon tea are provided daily. **(B,L)**
- Saturday  
April 18** **AUCKLAND-TAKAPUNA/TE AWAMUTU.** Morning (08.30) departure by private vehicle to the Waitomo Caves, via Huntley (approximately three hours). Guided tour of the Ruakuri Caves, named for the pack of wild dogs that used to inhabit them (Rua means 'den', kuri means 'dogs'). Lunch on own. Travel to Otorohanga to visit the Kiwi House & Native Bird Park. Continue to Te Awamutu for overnight and dinner with host families. **(B,D)**
- Sunday  
April 19** **TE AWAMUTU (ROTORUA).** Transfer by host family to Rose Gardens to meet private vehicle for a tour of Rotorua (approximately 1 hour and 45 minutes). Upon arrival tour the city, including the lakefront and Government Gardens. Visit of Te Puia, New Zealand's Maori Arts & Crafts Centre and Whakarewarewa Geothermal Reserve for a Maori concert, followed by a guided tour of Maori Pa (Village site). Take a skyline gondola to the *Skyline Restaurant* for group lunch (13.30). Included in the visit of the Skyline is a ride on the luge track. Return to Te Awamutu and host families for dinner. **(B,L,D)**
- Monday  
April 20** **TE AWAMUTU/AUCKLAND/LOS ANGELES.** After breakfast enjoy a farm tour with your host family followed by a late morning (11.00) departure by private vehicle for Auckland (2 hours and 15 minutes) to Discover New Zealand Visitor Centre for shopping and lunch on own. Afternoon (15.45) Pride of Auckland Coffee Cruise on the inner harbor, including tea or coffee and muffin, plus entrance to the Maritime Museum. Early evening transfer by private vehicle to the Auckland Airport for (21.30) departure on Air New Zealand flight NZ #2 to Los Angeles; non-stop Boeing 747 service with meals served en route. Arrive (2:30 p.m.) at Los Angeles International Airport, Tom Bradley International Terminal and clear customs. Re-check luggage and proceed to respective connecting flight. **(B)**
- LOS ANGELES/TWIN CITIES. Arrival.** Proceed to Terminal 2 for connecting departure (5:45 p.m.) on Northwest Airlines flight NW #310 for Minneapolis-St. Paul; non-stop Airbus 320 service

with food for purchase available en route. Arrive (11:13 p.m.) at Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport, Lindbergh Terminal.

**LOS ANGELES/CHICAGO Arrival.** Proceed to Terminal 4 for connecting departure (5:15 p.m.) on American Airlines flight AA #1890 for Chicago; non-stop Boeing 737 service with food for purchase available en route. Arrive (11:10 p.m.) at Chicago O'Hare International Airport, Terminal 3.

- **(B)** = breakfast, **(L)** = lunch, **(D)** = dinner. Breakfast is provided daily. One lunch included in Rotorua and two dinners. Meals not listed on this itinerary are the responsibility of the participant.
- All services listed in the itinerary are included in the course cost, including entrances at sites listed.
- Participants are responsible for own domestic air arrangements, unless prearranged directly through Seminars International. Participants will need a minimum of 1 hour and 30 minutes connecting time in Los Angeles for outbound flight and 2 hours minimum connecting time in Los Angeles for return flight.
- Participants are responsible for carrying their own luggage to and from the airport, vehicle and hotel.
- The 24-hour clock is used for travel outside of the United States. All times above 12.00 are in the afternoon or evening (simply subtract 12 hours from the time indicated, e.g., 12.00 is noon, 20.00 is 8:00 p.m.).

- **Important: Northwest and American Airlines charge a baggage fee of \$15.00 for your first bag, and \$25.00 for a second bag. Air New Zealand does not charge for the checked baggage. Bags must not exceed 50 pounds each.**
